

Parent's Right To Know

We would like for you to know that all school systems are required by federal law, the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA), to let you know about your child's teachers' qualifications. It is your right to request the following information about your child's teachers' training and credentials:

- Whether the teacher has met Georgia qualifications as licensing criteria for the grade level and subject matter in which the teacher provides instruction.
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which Georgia qualification or licensing requirements have been waived.
- Whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher.
- The teacher's college major, whether the teacher has an advanced degree, and, if so, the subject of the degree.
- Whether any paraprofessionals provide services to the child and, if so, their qualifications.

Please know that our staff is committed to helping your child reach his or her highest academic potential throughout their school career. That commitment includes making sure that all of our teachers and paraprofessionals are highly skilled and are providing quality instruction to your child.
